

The 68th Hokudai-sai Safety Management Rules

1. Introduction

To ensure the safe and smooth operation of the 68th Hokudai-sai, the Hokkaido University Festival Executive Committee (hereinafter referred to as “Hokudai-sai Committee”) will impose appropriate penalties on participating groups that commit acts obstructing this purpose (hereinafter referred to as “violations”). The participating groups in the 68th Hokudai-sai must comply with the penalties and other matters described below.

2. Overview

The following five penalties and other measures will be imposed on the participating groups that commit violations:

① Advisory Warning

If Hokudai-sai Staff determine that a participating group’s actions are highly likely to interfere with the safe operation of the Hokudai-sai, they will give the participating group a warning, provide guidance, and request improvement.

② Violation Points

Violation Points are points given to participating groups that commit violations. If no improvement is seen despite an Advisory Warning, Violation Points will be issued. However, if Hokudai-sai Staff judge that the violation poses significant danger or urgency, points may be issued without prior warning. Violation Points are accumulated during the 68th Hokudai-sai, and if a certain threshold is exceeded, the participating group will receive a Temporary Suspension or Permanent Suspension. Points will not be reduced except upon the lifting of a Temporary Suspension.

③ Compensation

If a participating group damages equipment or materials owned by Hokkaido University, any faculty, the Hokudai-sai Committee, Executive Committees of Each Festival, or the Office of the Hokkaido University Festival Executive Committee (hereinafter referred to as “Hokudai-sai Office”), or damages equipment or materials that are required or requested to be installed for the safety of the Hokudai-sai, the Hokudai-sai Committee, Executive Committees of Each Festival, or Hokudai-sai Office will demand compensation based on the distributed materials.

④ Temporary Suspension

This penalty is imposed when a participating group accumulates 30 Violation Points. As a general rule, once the penalty is decided, the participating group must suspend business for 2 hours from the time of the notice. However, if less than 2 hours remain in that day's Business Hours at the time of notice, the participating group must suspend business for the rest of the day. If the notice is given during Late Night During Hokudai-sai, the suspension will begin from the next Business Hours for 2 hours. The lifting of the suspension and the procedure for business resumption must be conducted in the presence of either the Chair or Vice Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee and at least one of either the participating group’s Leader, the Vice Leader, or Fire and Hygiene Safety Manager. Upon lifting of the suspension, regardless of the previously accumulated Violation Points, the participating group will restart business with 10 Violation Points.

⑤ Permanent Suspension

This penalty is imposed when a participating group accumulates 50 Violation Points. As a general rule, once this penalty is decided, the participating group must immediately cease business and begin removing their Section. All further activity by the participating group during the 68th Hokudai-sai will be prohibited from the time the permanent suspension notice is given.

3. Notification Process

① Advisory Warning

Delivered directly to the participating group by Hokudai-sai Staff.

② Issue of Violation Points

Delivered directly by Hokudai-sai Staff. Additionally, the Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee will request the Executive Committee of Each Festival to notify the participating group's Leader by email regarding the issue of Violation Points.

③ Request for Payment of Compensation

Delivered directly by Hokudai-sai Staff. The Chair of Hokudai-sai Committee will confirm the compensation purpose and payment destination, then request the Executive Committee of Each Festival to notify the participating group's Leader by email regarding the details.

④ Temporary Suspension

Delivered directly by Hokudai-sai Staff to the participating group that accumulated 30 Violation Points. The Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee will then notify both the Executive Committee of Each Festival and the relevant participating group's Leader directly or by email.

⑤ Permanent Suspension

Delivered directly by the Chair or Vice Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee to the participating group that accumulated 50 Violation Points. The Chair of Hokudai-sai Committee will then notify both the Executive Committee of Each Festival and the relevant participating group's Leader directly or by email.

4. Notes

- Violation Points are cumulative during the 68th Hokudai-sai and carry over to the following days.
- The Safety Management Rules established in this document correspond to “the rules and provisions established by the Hokkaido University Festival Executive Committee” stated in Clause 1 of the PLEDGE for the 68th Hokudai-sai.
- In this document, “During Hokudai-sai” refers to June 4 (Thu) 18:00 – June 8 (Mon) 6:00.
- “Late Night During Hokudai-sai” refers to the period outside a participating group's Business Hours.
- In this document, “Outdoor” indicates that the rule applies to outdoor participating groups.
- In this document, “Indoor” indicates that the rule applies to indoor participating groups.
- In this document, “All participating groups” indicates that the rule applies to all participating groups, both indoor and outdoor.

	Violation Details	Drinking alcohol, bringing in or selling alcoholic beverages (including non-alcoholic alcoholic-style beverages), or bringing in or selling food containing alcohol on the Campus. Mirin and cooking sake for cooking purposes are permitted.		
	Reason/Note	The Administration Office has notified that it must be prohibited during Hokudai-sai.		
	Penalty	Violation Points +50		
No.02	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Selling tobacco or smoking on the Campus.		
	Reason/Note	The Administration Office has notified that it must be prohibited during Hokudai-sai.		
	Penalty	Violation Points +50		
No.03	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Leaked gas or gasoline.		
	Reason/Note	Using fire nearby will cause it to ignite and burst into flames. <i>For safety reasons, participating groups in the surrounding Section may also be instructed to stop using fire equipment and generators.</i>		
	Penalty	Immediately stop using fire equipment. Operate electrical equipment switches at a distance, as sparks may cause ignition. Violation Points imposed		
No.04	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not complying with the use restrictions on fire equipment and generators imposed by Hokudai-sai Staff for fire prevention when a participating group in the surrounding Section has leaked gasoline.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk of developing into a large-scale fire. <i>If there are safety concerns, participating groups that have not leaked gasoline may also be asked to refrain from resuming activities for an extended period.</i> <i>The Hokudai-sai Committee bears no responsibility for any loss of opportunity caused by gasoline leakage or fire in surrounding participating groups.</i>		
	Penalty	Immediately stop using fire equipment and generators. Violation Points +30 <i>Depending on the extent of the gasoline leakage or fire, the period of temporary suspension may exceed 2 hours.</i>		
No.05	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not storing gasoline in a gasoline container.		
	Reason/Note	This is stipulated by Article 16 of the Fire Services Act.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.06	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	The lid of the gasoline container is not closed.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk that the gasoline may ignite and cause a fire.		

	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.07	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	The gasoline storage location is not appropriate for safety management. <i>(e.g. the gasoline container is placed near fire equipment, outside the tent, or in direct sunlight.)</i>		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk that the gasoline may ignite and cause a fire.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.08	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Using fire equipment that has not been applied for.		
	Reason/Note	The cause cannot be identified in the event of an accident.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.09	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	There is not sufficient distance between fire equipment being used and combustible materials, the tent, or decorations. <i>As a guideline, keep 30 cm from combustible materials and 100 cm from the tent canopy.</i>		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk that fire may spread from the fire equipment and cause a fire.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.10	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	A Fireproof Board wrapped in aluminum foil is not placed under the fire equipment being used.		
	Reason/Note	There is a very high risk that items under the fire equipment may catch fire. This has already been explained in the distributed materials and briefings.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.11	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Using a Fireproof Board without aluminum foil wrapped around it.		
	Reason/Note	There is a high risk that the Fireproof Board may catch fire.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.12	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Using high-heat fire equipment (e.g. charcoal-based equipment such as a shichirin) without placing Concrete Blocks underneath.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk that items under the fire equipment may catch fire. This has already been explained in the distributed materials and the briefings.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.13	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Using a cord reel without fully extending the cable.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk that the cord reel may be broken or melt due to heat.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.14	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups

	Violation Details	Caused a fire.		
	Reason/Note	It interferes with the safe operation of Hokudai-sai.		
	Penalty	Violation Points +30		
No.15	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	There is not sufficient distance between fluorescent lights and decorations.		
	Reason/Note	Decorations may catch fire due to the heat from fluorescent lights.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.16	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Damaging or losing a fire extinguisher.		
	Reason/Note	It may become impossible to respond in the event of a fire.		
	Penalty	Pay 6000 yen for a fire extinguisher replacement. Violation Points imposed		
No.17	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not displaying the Fire Extinguisher Zone Certificate despite being a Fire Extinguisher Zone.		
	Reason/Note	It cannot be confirmed whether the fire extinguisher is installed in an appropriate location.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.18	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	The fire extinguisher is not located directly below the Fire Extinguisher Zone Certificate, or in a location that can be extremely easily identified from the position of the Fire Extinguisher Zone Certificate.		
	Reason/Note	It may become impossible to respond in the event of a fire.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.19	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not picking up the fire extinguisher despite being designated to receive one.		
	Reason/Note	If a fire extinguisher is not placed in the Fire Extinguisher Zone, the response in the event of a fire will be delayed.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.20	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Misusing the dedicated refrigerator power source.		
	Reason/Note	Exceeding the available electricity consumption will cause inconvenience and disadvantage to other participants and visitors. The refrigerator of a participating group permitted to use the dedicated refrigerator power source has a permit attached. No application submitted except for Group Nos. 0011, 0027, 0031, 0033, and 0041.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.21	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups

	Violation Details	The generator is not placed outside the tent.		
	Reason/Note	Using a generator inside the tent poses an extremely high risk of carbon monoxide poisoning and fire.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.22	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	The outlet parts of the generator and cord reel are wet.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk that a fire may occur due to a short circuit.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.23	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	The generator exhaust outlet is facing toward objects.		
	Reason/Note	There is a high risk that surrounding items such as tent sidewalls may melt.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.24	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	There is excessive charring on grill nets or similar equipment.		
	Reason/Note	There is a risk of fire.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.25	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	No improvement is observed despite a warning from Hokudai-sai Staff, Firefighters, or others regarding various rules, matters, or fire safety.		
	Reason/Note	It interferes with the safe operation of Hokudai-sai.		
	Penalty	Violation Points +30		
No.26	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not displaying the Self-Check Sheet.		
	Reason/Note	The implementation status of the self-check for fire safety cannot be confirmed.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.27	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	None of the persons subject to the On-site Presence Requirement are present within the Section.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk that trouble may occur in terms of fire safety and hygiene.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed <i>Temporary suspension until the Hokudai-sai Committee confirms, in the presence of the Chair or Vice Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee, that at least one person subject to the On-site Presence Requirement is within the Section. Resumption of business shall be in accordance with the decision of the Hokudai-sai Committee.</i>		
No.28	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	Outdoor

	Violation Details	9 or more people are simultaneously active within the Section in a 4-pole small tent Section, 11 or more people in a 4-pole large tent Section, or 16 or more people in a 6-pole tent Section.		
	Reason/Note	For hygiene management within the Food Booth Section and maintaining a clean cooking environment.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.29	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Using cooking knives.		
	Reason/Note	To prevent food poisoning. To prevent the bacterial growth through cooking knives.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.30	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Serving uncooked food. <i>Fruits are excluded.</i> <i>Insufficiently cooked food is also prohibited.</i>		
	Reason/Note	To prevent food poisoning. To sterilize through full cooking.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.31	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Serving food that is not listed in the Food Ingredients List.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk of allergy-related trouble, and it is difficult for the Hokudai-sai Committee to bear the responsibility.		
	Penalty	Violation Points +30		
No.32	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not displaying the Food Ingredients List.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk of allergy-related trouble.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.33	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not possessing the Food Ingredients List.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high risk of allergy-related trouble.

	Violation Details	Leaving at room temperature any food or beverages used for cooking or provided that are not permitted to be left at room temperature under the Hokudai-sai Food Hygiene Guideline. <i>Including defrosting frozen items at room temperature.</i> <i>Bringing in food ingredients is permitted from 3 hours before the start of business. 	Violation Details	Performing processes within the Section that are not permitted, such as skewering or shaping into balls.		
	Reason/Note	Processes that the Health Center does not permit to be conducted within the Section are generally not allowed.

No.37	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Washing rice.		
	Reason/Note	To prevent human hands (including when wearing rubber gloves, etc) from touching the rice. Use pre-washed rice.

	Violation Details	Whipping fresh cream.		
	Reason/Note	The process of whipping fresh cream does not involve heating and results in non-heated serving. Use frozen whipped cream instead of fresh cream.

No.39	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Food handlers are not wearing Required Hygiene Products / Equipment (apron, head covering, rubber or vinyl disposable cooking gloves, disposable face mask).		
	Reason/Note	A clean cooking environment cannot be ensured.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.40	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Food handlers are wearing accessories (e.g. rings, necklaces, earrings, nail polish, bracelets).		
	Reason/Note	It is unhygienic if accessories directly or indirectly come into contact with food.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.41	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Creating blind spots within the Section.		
	Reason/Note	Hokudai-sai Staff and others cannot conduct hygiene checks accurately, and there is an extremely high risk that hygiene-related trouble may occur.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.42	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not setting up a Mini Water Station.		
	Reason/Note	Cooking utensils cannot be washed and hands cannot be sanitized, and a clean cooking environment cannot be ensured.

No.43	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not possessing equipment for the Mini Water Station.		
	Reason/Note	Cooking utensils cannot be washed and hands cannot be sanitized, and a clean cooking environment cannot be ensured.

No.44	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Clearly preparing large quantities of food in advance.		
	Reason/Note	It is difficult to manage the time elapsed since the food was prepared.

	Violation Details	Engaging in selling food outside tents or conducting food or drink sampling.		
	Reason/Note	It cannot be determined where and who ate what, and it is difficult to manage the time elapsed since the food was prepared.

No.46	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Food handlers are conducting monetary transactions, or personnel responsible for monetary transactions are conducting cooking.		
	Reason/Note	It is unhygienic to handle food with hands that have touched money handled by an unspecified number of people.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.47	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Using non-disposable tableware to serve food and reusing it.		
	Reason/Note	Unsanitary tableware may become a source of pathogens and there is an extremely high risk of causing food poisoning.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.48	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Providing food or beverages in the tent without enclosing three sides with tent sidewalls or similar (excluding cases where there is a fire risk).		
	Reason/Note	There are concerns about deterioration of hygiene caused by contamination by dust and trash.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.49	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Providing food or beverages in the tent without possessing tent sidewalls or similar to enclose three sides.		
	Reason/Note	There are concerns about deterioration of hygiene caused by contamination by dust and trash.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.50	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups

	Violation Details	Improvements are not observed in response to a warning regarding various rules, matters, and hygiene safety from Hokudai-sai Staff, Health Center Staff, or others.		
	Reason/Note	It interferes with the safe operation of Hokudai-sai.		
	Penalty	Violation Points +30		
No.51	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Operating fire equipment during Late Night During Hokudai-sai.		
	Reason/Note	It is difficult to secure sufficient Hokudai-sai Staff, firefighters, and others to respond to fire incidents that occur during Late Night During Hokudai-sai, and there is an extremely high risk of developing into a serious accident.		
	Penalty	Immediately stop using fire equipment and similar equipment. Violation Points +30		
No.52	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Food is left at room temperature during Late Night During Hokudai-sai. <i>Including defrosting frozen items at room temperature.</i>		
	Reason/Note	There is a risk of bacterial growth.		
	Penalty	Violation Points +30		
No.53	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Four or more people are conducting Overnight Equipment Watch.		
	Reason/Note	It causes disturbance to surrounding areas due to noise.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.54	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Disposing of garbage at the garbage station during Late Night During Hokudai-sai.		
	Reason/Note	At the garbage station, Hokudai-sai Staff provide guidance on waste hygiene management and environmentally responsible sorting so that visitors can comfortably enjoy Hokudai-sai. Therefore, disposal of garbage during Late Night During Hokudai-sai, when staff are not present, is prohibited. During Late Night During Hokudai-sai, each participating group must take their garbage back, as arbitrary disposal may cause campus pollution, bad odors, or damage by crows.

No.55	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Entering the Campus with an unregistered vehicle (excluding bicycles), including entry outside the application hours.		
	Reason/Note	It is extremely dangerous and makes it difficult to respond if an accident occurs.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.56	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Not displaying the Car Pass.		
	Reason/Note	It becomes difficult to confirm whether vehicles entering the Campus have been applied for.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.57	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups

	Violation Details	Parking or stopping vehicles (excluding bicycles) at a place immediately before the campus entry point, without entering the Campus. (e.g. the North 18 rotary, in front of the Administration Office)		
	Reason/Note	It may obstruct other pedestrians and vehicles, and hinder smooth operation.

	Violation Details	Ignoring directions or engaging in dangerous driving on the Main Street (e.g. unauthorized turning or reckless driving).		
	Reason/Note	There is a high risk that a traffic accident may occur.

	Violation Details	Caused a traffic accident.		
	Reason/Note	There is an extremely high possibility that it affects the safe operation of Hokudai-sai.		
	Penalty	Report to the police Violation Points +30 <i>Depending on the time required to handle the accident, the period of temporary suspension may exceed 2 hours.</i>		
No.60	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Parking a bicycle outside designated bicycle parking areas.		
	Reason/Note	The spaces between tents serve as evacuation routes and passageways, and blocking them with bicycles may cause congestion and lead to accidents or injuries. Also, it may lead to an increase in abandoned bicycles.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.61	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Handling equipment or supplies owned by the rental company, the University, or the Hokudai-sai Office roughly, or not following the prescribed usage instructions.		
	Reason/Note	Rented items, tables, chairs, blackout curtains, and equipment (including items fixed in classrooms) are not the property of the participating groups.		
	Penalty	Violation Points imposed		
No.62	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Damaging equipment or supplies owned by the rental company, the University, or the Hokudai-sai Office.
